HACHIKO story behind the name

Hachiko is the name of the dog that was gifted to an agriculture professor, Mr. Hidesaburo Ueno, by a Buddhist monk in 1924 in Japan. Due to the close bond of love they shared, Hachiko greeted its master while his routine of university on railway station daily every morning and evening. The pair continued this daily ritual for 3 years, till the day Professor Ueno did not return. The professor had suffered from cerebral hemorrhage and died, never returning to the train station where Hachikō was waiting. Every day for the next nine years the dog waited at railway station. Hachikō became a national sensation. His faithfulness to his master's memory impressed the people of Japan as a spirit of family loyalty all should strive to achieve. Hachiko died in 1934 but he has always been remembered for his unflinching loyalty since then.











Parashar Agritourism is registered center with MTDC [Maharashtra Tourism Development Corporation] under Mahabhraman Scheme. Parashar Agritourism has started its work with celebrating Maharashtra's 1st Grape Festival in April 2011. We have started our accommodation facilities since 4th Sept 2011. With working we have followed some discipline to serve our guests. As our culture is known for "Atithi Devo Bhav" and "Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam" it is our responsibility to be on it. Through Parashar Agritourism we are trying to do so.

Agriculture is not only farming but its culture of human being. Fortunately we are living in such country where we can eat fresh food on each day. We have to focus on it. At Parshar Agritourism, we are celebrating so many festivals throughout the year. Grape festival [!5th Jan-10th April], Jatra Festival and Tamasha [Maharashtra folk art] festival during Holi period, Village Festival in August, Rainy festival, Diwali festival, Kojagiri Festval and many more.

- Vighnhar, Ozar: One of the Ashtvinayaka Temple30 km from us.
- Girijatmaj, Lenaydri: One of the Ashtavinayaka temple & Bhudhist caves 40 km from us.
- Gibson Garden: India's 1st forest officer's garden 20 km from us.
- Tulaja Caves: 2500 yrs old Budhist caves 55 km from us.
- Chavand Fort: 60 km from us.
- Kukadeshwar Temple: Ancient temple & starting of Kukadi river 60 km from us.
- Nane Ghat, Jivdhan fort: Ancient trading route of Satvahan dynasties 70 km from us.
- Hadsar Fort, Nimgiri Fort, Shindola Fort, Kombad-Ranjan Fort : 50-60 km from us
- Malshej Ghat: Natural rustic beauty 40 km from us.
